Mentors

- Take the initiative to contact your mentee and stay in touch.
- Communicate your expectations.
- Take initiative in the relationship, but allow your mentee to exercise responsibility.
- Devote time to the relationship: schedule at least one meeting of one hour every two weeks.
- Create a plan with your mentee.
- Establish explicit goals and objectives for the relationship and review these midway.
- Respect the confidentiality of information shared.
- Be open to new ideas and feedback and celebrate success.
- Provide support, feedback and help the mentee through difficult situations.
- Communicate and discuss the benefits of being a BP Fellow in meetings.

Mentees

- Take the initiative and take advantage of the opportunities provided.
- Communicate your expectations.
- Drive the relationship with respect and friendship.
- Devote time to the relationship: schedule at least one meeting of one hour every two weeks.
- Be considerate of your mentor's time and show appreciation for it.
- Create a plan with your mentor.
- Keep your mentor updated on academic/personal progress, success, challenges and concerns.
- Establish the line of communication preferences for both.
- Respect the confidentiality of information shared.
- Ask for advice, be open to new ideas and welcome feedback.
